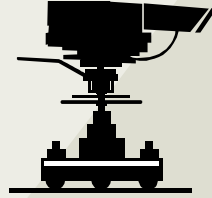

Over the past few months OCTV has been experimenting with live-stream video. Particularly, we are concentrating on streaming more programs produced in the studio. Perhaps by September we will be able to live stream a few sporting events and government meetings.

New Editing Systems Ordered

On May 16th we placed an order with Micro Center in Troy for 3 new Mac editing systems. They are the iMac Pros and are considered the most advanced editing systems available today. We are currently using a Windows-based PC system and the interface between them will be smooth, according to our IT specialists. The new editors will allow us to work at a more efficient rate. They will also give us the capabilities of increasing the image quality we put on the air. Our media storage capacity will increase immensely, as well.

Re-runs

You will see more repeat shows on our network this summer as we settle back for the warmer days. But that does not mean we are not hard at work. In fact, the staff will be "pounding the rock" with creating new shows. We will also be working to bring you faster and much more relevant programming this fall. The events we will cover this season will be with greater detail in coverage, like using multiple cameras for Music In The Park.
